TILT UP CONSTRUCTION FOR SUPERVISORS

Course Code ATM011A

NOTE:

It is recommended that candidates have completed the 'Identify Requirements for Safe Tilt-Up Work' course and are capable of passing an AQF Level qualification .

AIM OF THE COURSE / TARGET GROUP

This course provides participants with the required knowledge and skill to equip them to safely supervise work in tilt-up construction. The course provides a blend of meaningful theoretical instruction with practical training based on simulated tilt-up construction situations and practical application on site of safe tilt-up construction procedures. This course is suitable for those who supervise tilt up construction activities.

DURATION

1 day in class theory + Practical Assessment

COURSE CONTENT

This course is based on the requirements outlined in the Regulations, Code of Practice and Standards and includes:

- Worksafe notification requirements
- Code of Practice recommendations
- Documentation
- Work Method Statements and JSAs
- Emergency planning and procedures
- Construction sequencing
- Crane operations
- Propping
- Inspection requirements
- Emergency response procedures

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Knowledge based questionnaires, classroom exercises and completion of workplace assignments.

PRE-REQUISITE FOR THIS COURSE

Must have:

- **Current** Tilt-Up Construction Industry experience
- Good English literacy skills
- Construction Industry Bluecard / Whitecard
- Completed any of the following:
 - Contribute to safe tilt up construction, or
 - CPCCCM1007A Carryout tilt-up work safely, or
 - CPCCCM1016A Identify requirements for safe tilt-up work

CRITICAL NOTE:

To complete the post-course practical activities, candidates must be able to demonstrate competence by supervising the erection of at least one 10 tonne panel on their own site AND have a log book signed off by Site Supervisor and Engineer within 6 months of course completion.

ACADEMIC AWARD AND RECOGNITION

Upon successful completion participants will be issued with either of the following Statements of Attainment relevant to their industry area which will be recognised nationally

- CPCCBC4022A Supervise tilt-up work

WHAT TO WEAR

All course participants are required to wear neat casual attire and closed in shoes.

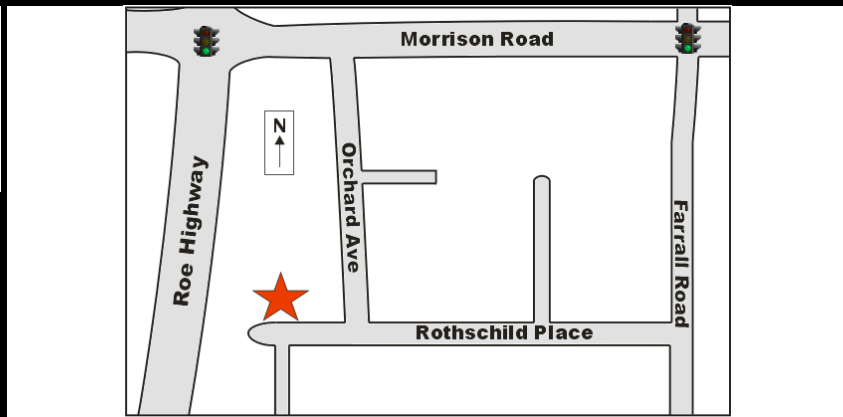
