Traineeship Pathways

Persons who are employed either full time or on a permanent part-time basis for a minimum of 20 hours per week can apply for this traineeship.

Employees who have been employed for more than 3 months are classified as 'existing workers'. Employers can receive payroll tax exemptions for eligible new employee trainees.
